GENERAL INFORMATION

The Automatic lubricators are supplied with 2 different strength springs. Each spring is designed to provide different grease pressures, which is required depending on grease viscocity.

The yellow spring (medium tension) is designed for greases up to NLGI no2. (refer to table 1)

The Black spring (strong tension) is designed for greases up to NLGI no4 (refer to table 1)

If you experience any problems with this product, please contact your nearest Macnaught Distributor, or Authorised Macnaught Service Centre.

SPRING SELECTION

Select the spring required, refer to table 1.

1) Carefully unscrew the cylinder from the head assembly.

Note: The cylinder is under spring tension.

- 2) Remove the spring from the lubricator and replace with the required strength spring, (refer to table 1).
- 3) Carefully screw the cylinder onto the head assembly and lock together firmly.

OPERATION

1) Fit the 10mm x 1mm outlet thread on the lubricator to the desired greasing point on your equipment.



- 2) Fully close the flow adjusting screw.
- 3) With the use of a standard grease gun, attach the grease gun coupler to the grease nipple located on the side of the lubricator and fill the lubricator with grease.
- 4) Adjust the flow adjusting screw to give the desired flow rate.
- **Note:** The face of the adjusting screw has 12, 6, 3, 1 month markings stamped on it. This represents the amount of time to empty the lubricator from full.

Regulate to the desired flow, rotate the adjusting screw and aligning the desired number with the line engraved on the adjusting screw body.
